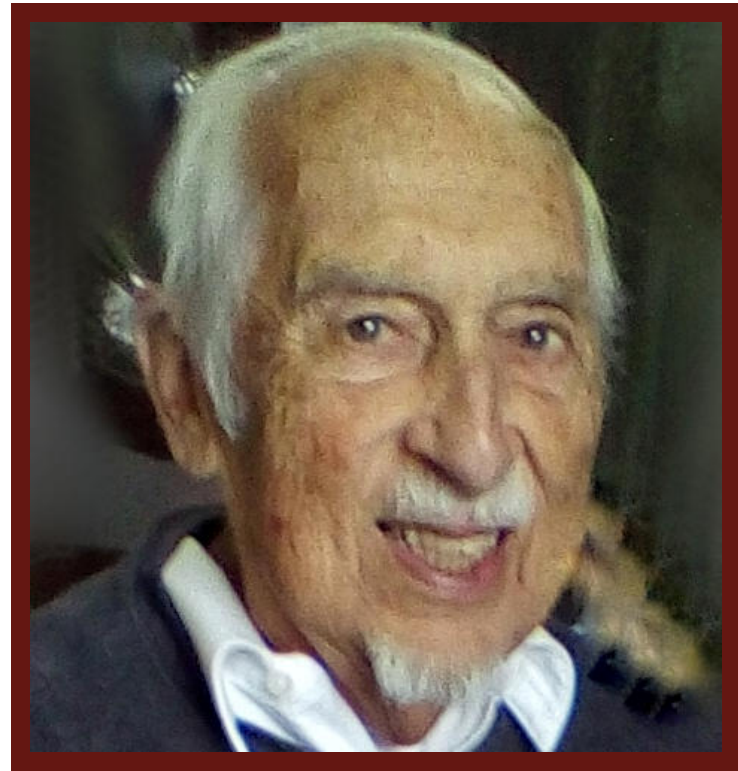
He is preceded in death by his parents, Mary Lou, his first wife and mother of his children, and a grandson Clay Sewell.
