It is for good reasons, but can be a little cumbersome. We have tried to simplify this document as much as possible within federally mandated constraints. The goods and services shown below are those we can provide to our customers. You may choose only the items you desire. However, any funeral arrangements you select will include a charge for our basic services and overhead. If legal or other requirements mean you must buy any items you did not specifically ask for, we will explain the reason in writing on the statement we provide describing the funeral goods and services you selected.

Professional Services

Basic Services of the funeral director & staff: \$1400

Our fee for basic services of funeral director and staff includes

- Staff to respond to initial request for service, 24 hours a day
- Arrangement conference with family and/or responsible parties
- Planning services
- Recording vital statistics
- Preparation and filing of necessary authorizations and permits
- Preparation and placement of obituary notice
- Preparation for unembalmed viewing
- Viewing/Ritual - up to 1 hour during business hours
Includes: washings, dressings, anointings, cultural & religious rites, etc.
- Coordination with other service providers (i.e., terramation & aquamation facilities, cemetery, crematory, and others as requested)
- Overhead expenses such as regulatory fees, professional service fees, insurance, facility costs, taxes, equipment, inventory, and administrative expenses.

This fee for our basic services will be added to the total cost of the funeral arrangements you select. This fee is already included in our charges for direct terramation, aquamation, cremation, and burial, and forwarding or receiving remains.

Automotive Equipment & Transportation

- Transfer to funeral home (within a 30 mile radius of our facility): \$350

Care and Preparation of the Body

- Sheltering in temperature controlled facility (additional \$30/day after seventh day): \$250

- Embalming: \$500*

*Embalming is performed by a state-licensed professional. It is a chemical process which provides temporary preservation of the body and eliminates certain health hazards. Except in certain special cases, embalming is not required by law. Embalming may be necessary, however, if you select certain funeral arrangements, such as a funeral with viewing. If you do not want embalming, you usually have the right to choose an arrangement that does not require you to pay for it, such as a direct cremation or immediate burial.

Generally embalming is an unnecessary procedure that we discourage, even for most viewings. However, there are times when it is advantageous. For instance, when a viewing is requested but must be delayed more than 5 to 7 days after death, for certain cultural rites, or when repatriating a foreign national to their home country. In such cases we use a line of safe, effective, non-toxic, embalming chemicals. They are based on a complex mix of essential plant-based oils and keep both our staff and our environment safe. Please note that embalming is prohibited when selecting terramation.

If you want to arrange a direct cremation, you can use an alternative container or cremation container. Alternative containers encase the body and can be made of materials like fiberboard or composition materials. The alternative minimum cremation container we provide is constructed of cardboard.

When selecting immediate burial, no provision is made for attendance by the family, friends, or clergy at the graveside. If you want to arrange for an immediate burial, you can use an alternative container or any casket. Please see attached Casket Price List. Alternative containers encase the body and can be made of materials like fiberboard or composition materials (with or without an outside covering). The minimum container we provide is constructed of cardboard.

Immediate burial with container provided by purchaser: \$2600

Immediate burial with casket purchased at Wildflower \$3199 - highest casket

Child Services

- Fetal demise under 20 week gestation: 100% discount on professional services
- Fetal demise over 20 week gestation: 75% discount on professional services
- Infant to age 4: 50% discount on professional services
- Age 4 to 16: 25% discount on professional services
- 15% discount on all merchandise

Discounts do not apply to disposition process fees and cash advances as these are paid to outside entities.

Outer Burial Containers

In most areas of the country, state or local law does not require that you buy a container to surround the casket in the grave. However, many cemeteries require that you have such a container so that the grave will not sink in. Either a grave liner or a burial vault will satisfy these requirements.

Wildflower Funeral Concepts does not sell outer burial containers. If you have selected burial arrangements in a cemetery that requires an outer burial container we can assist with that purchase from the cemetery.
