The goods and services shown on the following pages are those we can provide to our customers. You may choose only the options you desire. However, any funeral arrangements you select will include a charge for our services. If legal or other requirements mean you must buy any items you did not specifically ask for, we explain the reason in writing on the statement we provide describing the goods and services you selected.

### **PROFESSIONAL SERVICES**

#### Basic Professional Services of the Funeral Director and Staff: \$ 1,900.00

This fee includes, but is not limited to: availability of funeral director and staff 24 hours a day; Receiving notification of death; Coordinating release of deceased from place of death; Liaison with doctor, coroner and/or medical examiner; Making funeral arrangements with the family or responsible parties; Preparing, filing, routing and/or obtaining signatures for all necessary documents, which includes but is not limited to, death certificates and social security notification. Also included in this charge are propionate allocations of overhead expenses relative to our facilities such as maintenance and utility expenses, secretarial and administrative costs, general operating expenses and ongoing professional licensing requirements.

This fee for our basic services and overhead will be added to the total cost of the funeral arrangements you select.

\*This fee is already included in our charges for direct cremation.

#### Alternative Care of Remains: \$ 525.00

If for religious or other reasons embalming is declined, the Wisconsin State Board of Health (State Statute HHS 136.04) requires a licensed embalmer to perform alternative sanitary care of the deceased.

#### Other Preparation and Care of the Deceased

Dressing, Cosmetology, and Casketing \$ 420.00

Reconstructive Restoration (when necessary) \$ 160.00/hour

Hairdresser \$ 105.00

Shelterization / Refrigeration (in certain instances when a delay in disposition is required by law) \$ 75.00/day

### Transportation

Unless otherwise noted, all transportation charges contained in this General Price List apply to the local area only (within a 25 mile radius of the Funeral Home) Add \$3.50 for each mile outside the local area.

Expenses, such as hotels, meals, tolls, etc., will be added charges for out of town funerals and transfers.

Transfer of Remains to the Funeral Home \$ 525.00

Transfer of Remains to the Crematory or for Autopsy \$ 525.00

Transfer of Remains from Residence \$300.00

### **DIRECT CREMATION**

Direct Cremation \$ 995.00

This charge includes the following: Continuous 24-hour availability of Funeral Director and staff for receiving notification of death and coordinating release of the deceased from place of death. Administrative, secretarial and staff services for preparing, filing, routing and/or obtaining signatures for all documents such as: original death certificate copies of and notification of Social Security. Coordinating and filing cremation permits with the Medical Examiner and all necessary crematory forms. This fee includes local transportation from the place of death to the funeral home, alternative care of the deceased (Wis. Statute 136.04), alternative container, transportation on to the crematory, and a temporary cremains container. This charge does not include funeral planning and payment is required in full prior to cremation.
